

# OFF LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

ARLA Ref: 53/OFF/694/2019

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **CAIPIRINHA LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **98 Edmund Avenue, Kaikoura** and known as **"Henry's Beer Wine Spirits Kaikoura"** to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of alcohol on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

## CONDITIONS – SECTION 116 (1-2)

- (a) No Alcohol may be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1pm on ANZAC Day.
- (b) No Alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit, or vegetable wine made on the premises.
- (c) Alcohol may only be sold or delivered only on the following days and during the following hours:

**Monday to Sunday from 8.00am to 10.00pm**

- (d) Signage must be displayed stating (directly or by description) a place or places on the premises at which drinking water is freely available to customers, while alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
- (e) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - Display of appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- (f) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the management of the premises concerned are observed:
  - Alcohol must only be sold, and supplied within the area marked on the plan submitted with the application.
- (g) The premises shall be designated as **Supervised**

## THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises situated 98 Edmund Avenue, Kaikoura are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan submitted.

## DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises.


## DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) either -
  - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either –
  - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

Subject to the requirements above, **the licence expires on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of July 2022**, unless again renewed.
